Please note: there are some variable additional costs:

Computer/laptop	Although the school provides excellent computer facilities, we do advise students to purchase a laptop. If the student wants to make use of the school's network, then he/she can contact the school's help desk in order to adapt the laptop to the school's wireless network.
Books	Books can be bought from the school's supplier. Other lesson material consists mainly of a course guide and a reader. The course guide contains important information for each course, such as the number of ECs it provides, who the lecturers are, etc. Readers provide additional reading material to supplement the books.
